Religious Education Volunteer Opportunity Descriptions

Crossing Guard Crossing guards will sign up via sign up genius for approx. one Sunday a month to help direct traffic in parking lot before and after classes. (8:55 – 9:20 & 10:10 – 10:30)

Hall Monitor – Volunteers will sign up via sign up genius for either 1st or 2nd floor hall monitor (9:00 – 10:25 AM) They will assist catechist when needed, monitor hall way for strangers, contact director or secretary in case of emergency & make sure all class room doors & windows are locked at end of program. **(Safeguarding Required)**

Program Photographer - Take photos on Sundays of Religious Education classes & special events **(Safeguarding Required)**

Catechist Aide: Help a Catechist in the classroom weekly **(Safeguarding Required)**

Catechist Sub: Be on a list of people willing to fill in for catechist who is sick or out of town **(Safeguarding Required)**

CLOW - Children's Liturgy of the Word Leader: 10:30 Mass at HF (September – May) Leads children in scripture and discussion usually once a month **(Safeguarding Required)**

EDGE Leader: Leads a small group of 7th /8th grade students as part of the middles school EDGE program. The program is 6:30 – 8:00 on the 2nd Thursday of the month November – April. **(Safeguarding Required)**

VBS Leader Vacation Bible Program: 2nd Week of Aug. Adult leaders in crafts, snacks, games, music, focus, registration - prep work **(Safeguarding Required)**

Religious Education Advisory Board: Made up of parishioners, parents and catechists who are interested in assisting and advising the DRE in the development of the program. The REAB they meet approx. once a month (Sept. – May)

St. Nick Fest: The 1st Saturday of Advent - Chairperson(s) choose crafts and games for event & organize the volunteers. Volunteers help with prep, setup, crafts and clean up on the day of event. This event Held at Holy Family.

Bread Baking: Help the First Communion Students with their bread baking activity one Sunday before class

Catechists' weekly treats & food for In-service and End of year meeting: Chairperson puts together schedule of treats for Sundays & catechist events. Volunteers bring food in on Sundays, January In-service and May End of year brunch

Fall Caramel Apple Sale: 2nd weekend in October – Chairperson responsible to pick up apples, get supplies and organizes volunteers to sell apples after all the Masses.

City Tin Sale: Help in organizing and promoting the annual city tin sale

Palm Sunday Bake Sale: Help organize, promote and get volunteers to run the Palm Sunday bake sale 4/5/2020

House of Peace Thanksgiving Collection: Assist in counting & boxing the donated food. November 24, 2019

House of Peace Lenten Hygiene Bag Collection: Assist in collecting items from church weekly as well as from the class rooms. Sort items weekly and box them for pick up by the house of peace.

Class Service Project Parent: Assist catechist of chosen grade level in identifying, organizing and conducting a class service project. 5-10 hours.
